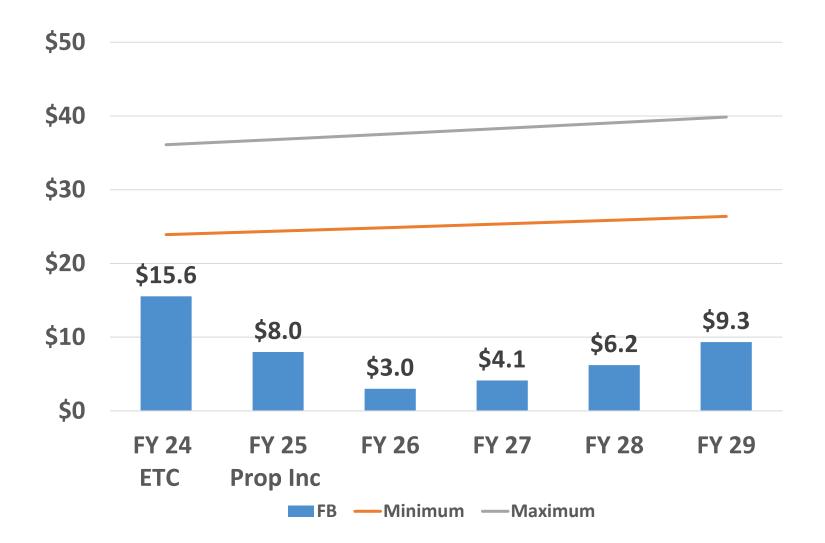

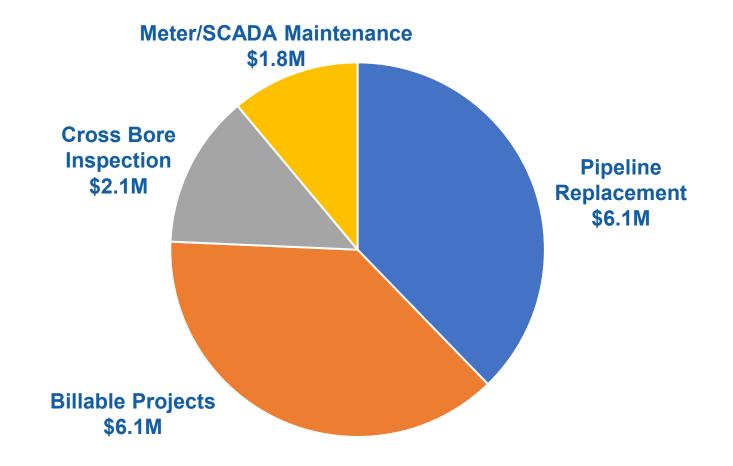

Gas Fund Balance Projection



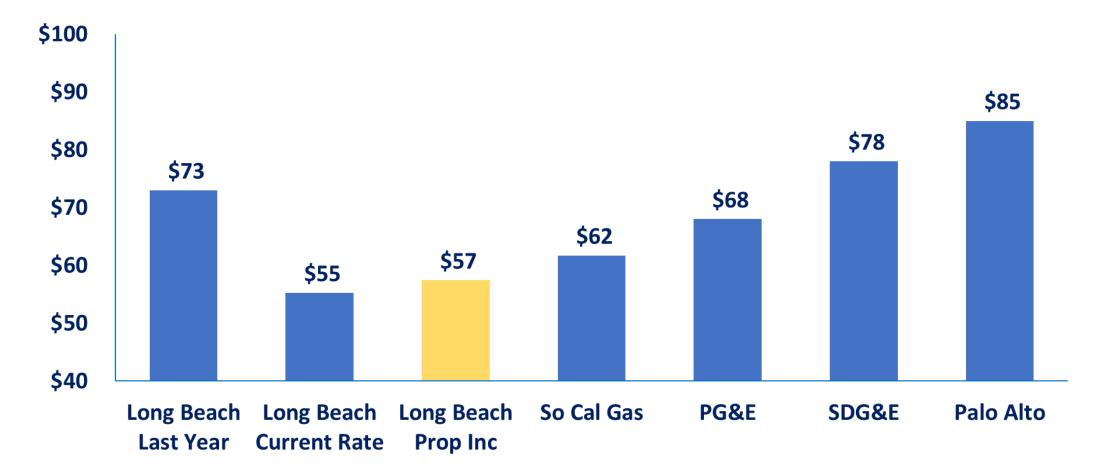
FY 25 Gas Fund CIP (\$16.1M)

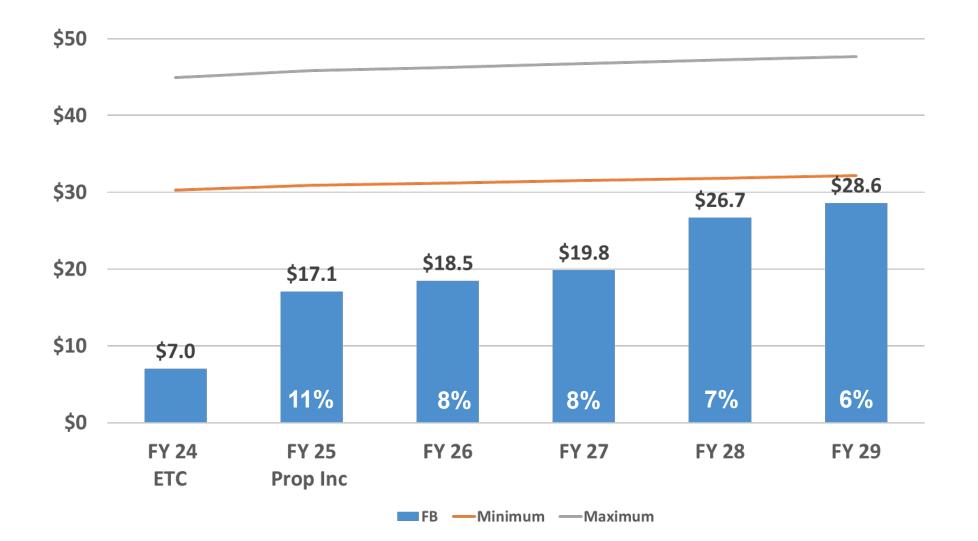

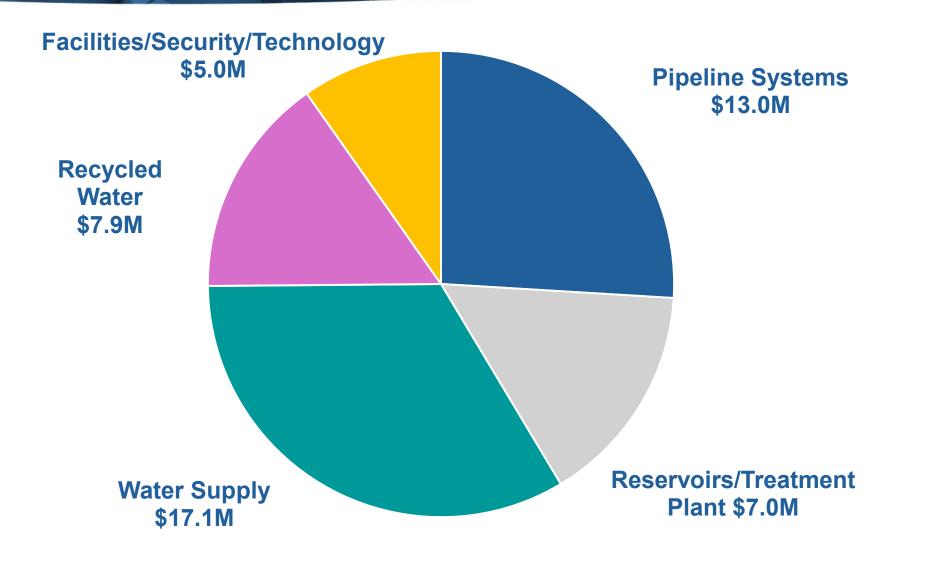

Average Water Bill - CA City Benchmarking



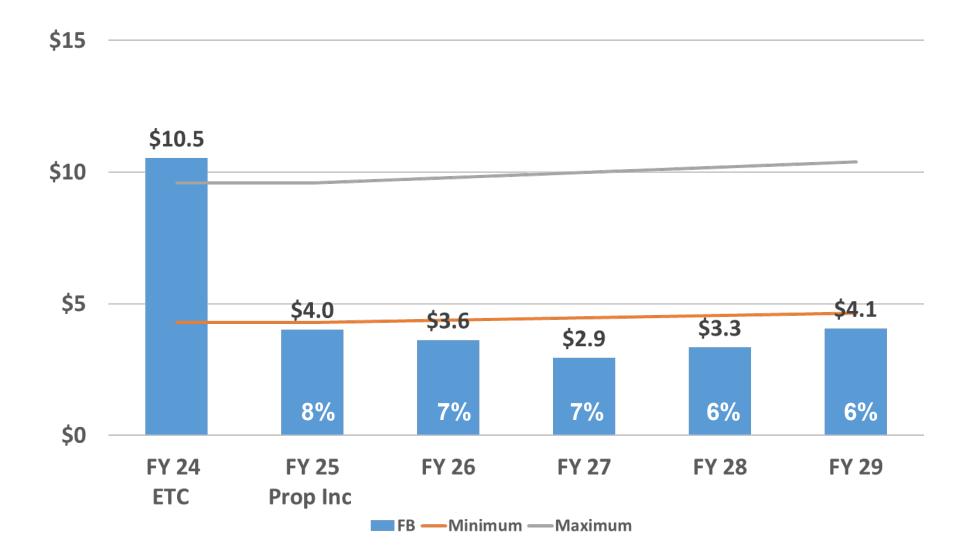

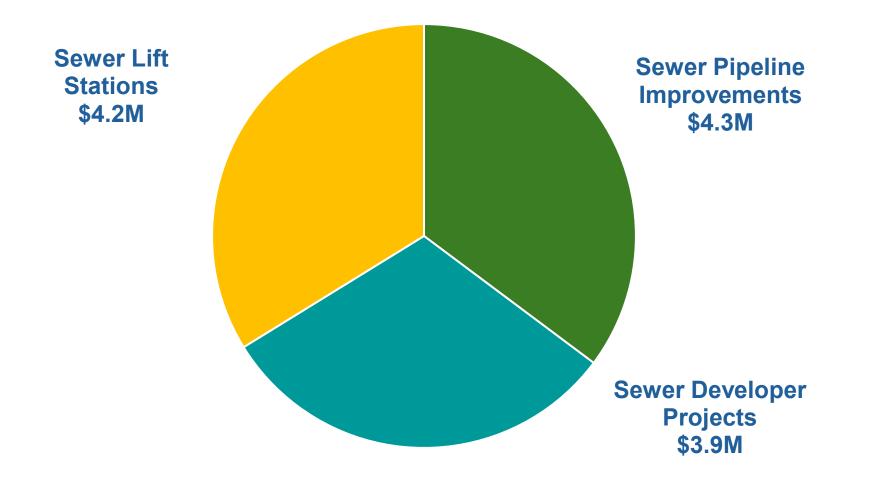

FY 25 Sewer Fund CIP (\$12.4M)

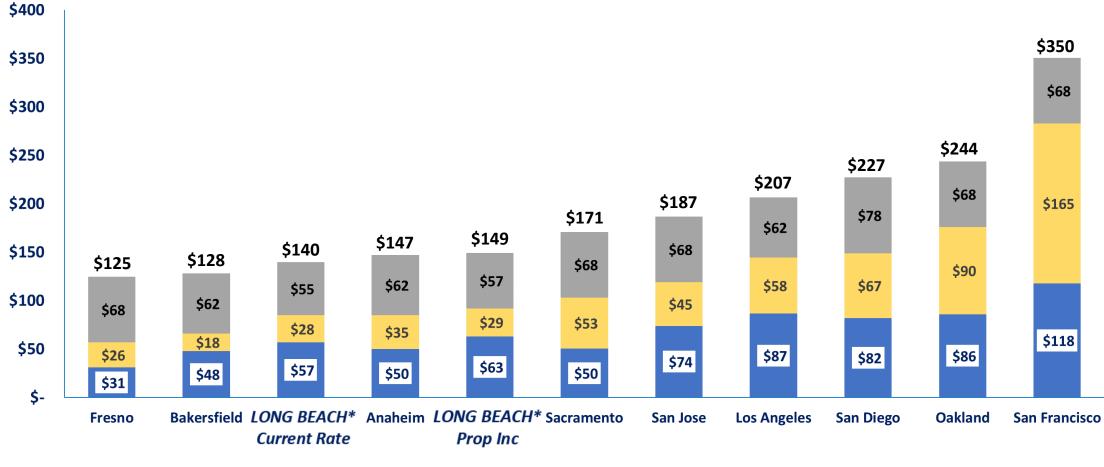


FY 25 Staff Recommendation

• Rates for FY 25

- 11% water rate increase (+\$6.25/month)
- 8% sewer rate increase (+\$0.91/month)
- 4% gas rate increase (+\$2.16/month)
- Continued investments in new well development to maximize access to less expensive groundwater and critical repair and maintenance to nearly 4,000 miles of pipeline
- Build up minimum reserves

FY 25 Budget Approval Process

- Today Adopt FY 25 Rates and Budget
- July-August Budget Briefings with Mayor and City Council
 - August 22 Prop 218 Hearing
 - **September** City Council Adoption

October – Budget and Rates Effective October 1, 2024

Adopt Resolution UT-1518, a Resolution of the City of Long Beach Board of Utilities Commissioners fixing rates and charges for water, sewer, and gas services to all customers, subject to the approval of the City Council by Ordinance, and subject to a public protest hearing as provided for in the California Constitution Article XIII. Adopt Resolution UT-1519, adopting the annual budget for the Long Beach Utilities Department for the fiscal year 2024-2025 and authorize staff to transmit the Resolution and the budget to the City Manager, Mayor, and City Council.
